## Field Activity Advisory San Joaquin River Groundwater Monitoring Network Survey February 2019

The San Joaquin River Restoration Program (SJRRP) is preparing to conduct elevation surveys of the groundwater monitoring network located throughout the San Joaquin River Restoration Area in order to verify coordinates and update elevations affected by subsidence and for newly installed wells.

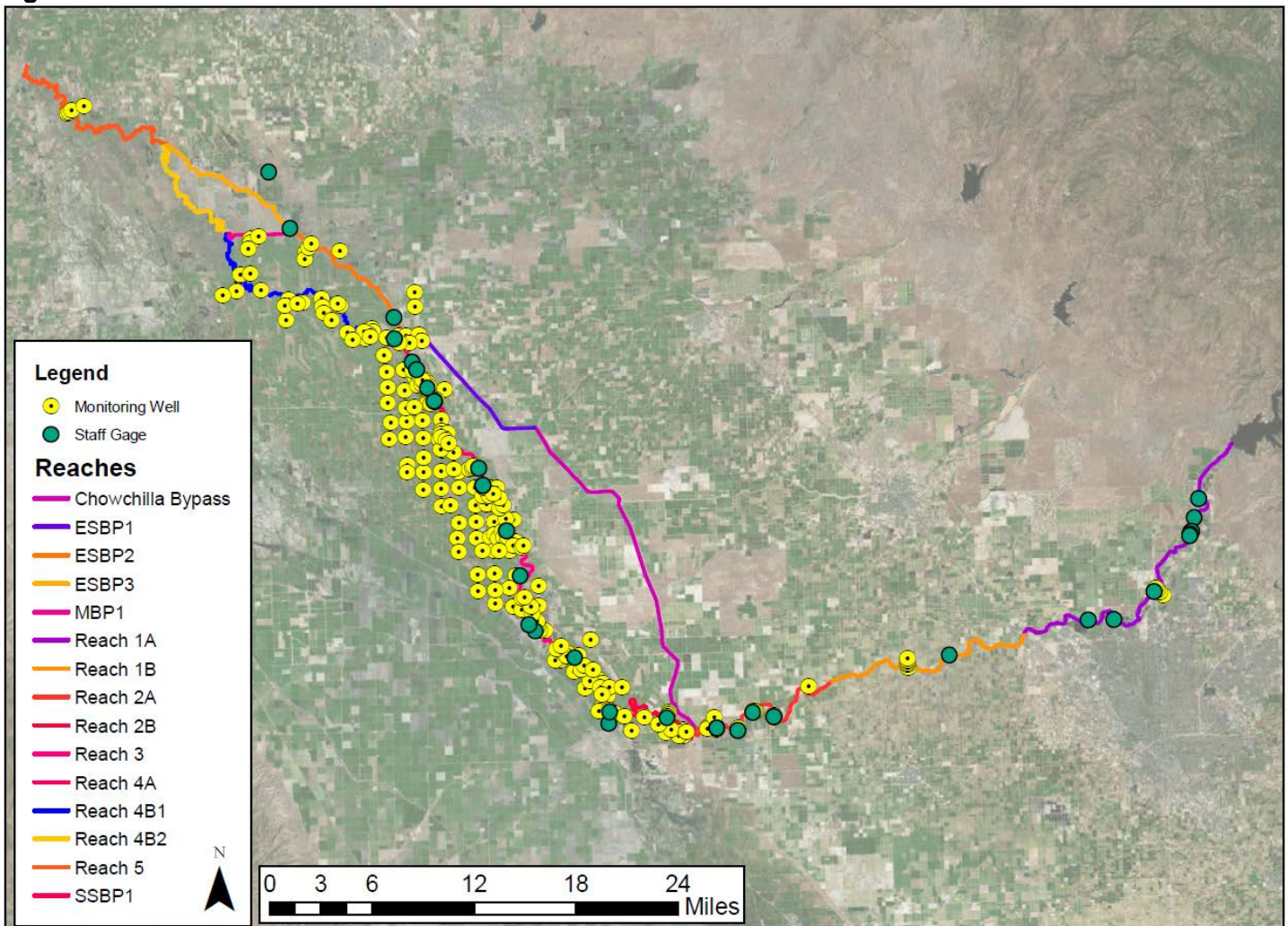
**Who:** U.S. Bureau of Reclamation

**What:** Reclamation surveying staff will be conducting elevation surveys throughout the Restoration Area to update elevations of monitoring wells affected by subsidence. Elevations will be collected at the top of well casing, at the well ground surface, and at the ground surface of the adjacent field for all active wells in the groundwater monitoring network. This information will ensure that all elevation data is current which is particularly important to threshold elevations in the Seepage Management Plan. In addition, elevations will be collected for staff gages along the river to calibrate staff gage measurements.

**When:** Week of February 11, 2019 and the week of February 25, 2019 (weather depending)

**Where:** Reach 1-5 of the San Joaquin River Restoration Area (see Figure A below)
