Groundwater Well Installation

May & June 2019

The San Joaquin River Restoration Program (SJRRP) is preparing to install a groundwater well on the Merced National Wildlife Refuge as part of the Eastside Bypass Improvement Project. The well will provide the refuge with an additional water supply and will be drilled as shallow well above the Corcoran clay layer.

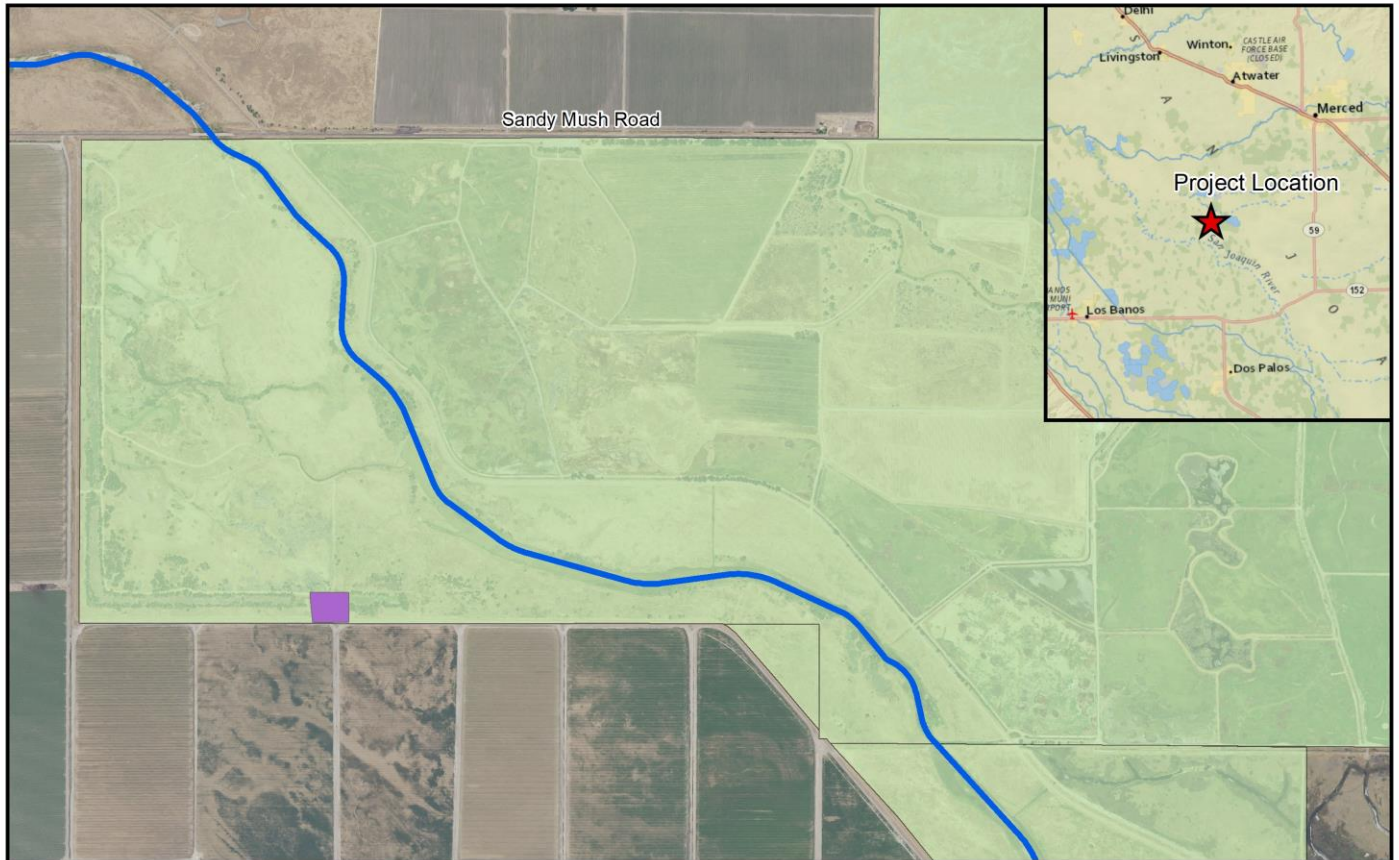
What: Groundwater well installation

Where: Construction will take place on the Merced National Wildlife Refuge. Access for the construction will occur on public roads and on the refuge by permit.
