



Field Activity Advisory Former MLT Property Geotechnical Data Collection May 28 – June 3, 2020

The San Joaquin River Restoration Program (SJRRP) will conduct pre-construction geotechnical surveys for the Mendota Pool Bypass and Reach 2B Improvements Project. A survey truck will be on-site and will access the site using local roadways. The graphic below illustrates where the work will take place on the former MLT Property West (left side of shaded green).

Who: U.S. Bureau of Reclamation

What: Reclamation will conduct geotechnical pre-construction surveys

When: May 28 – June 3, 2020

Where: The surveys will occur on the parcel of land, previously owned by Mitigation Lands Trust, now owned by the Federal Government. Survey access will occur through Drive 10.5.

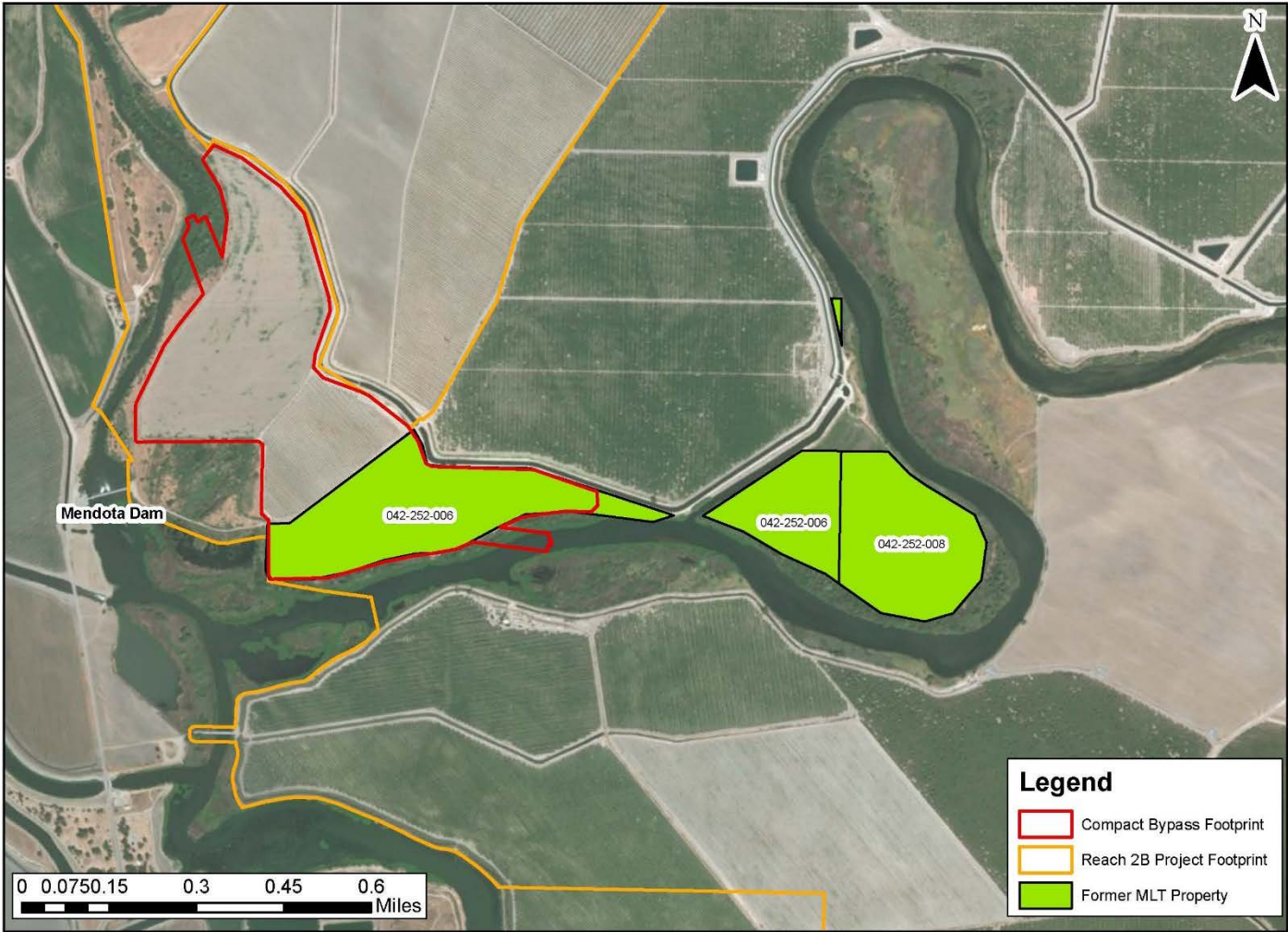
