



## Field Activity Advisory Mowry Bridge Replacement Project Pre-Construction Activities

August-September 2020

The San Joaquin River Restoration Program (SJRRP) is initiating pre-construction activities in advance of a City of Mendota project to replace the existing Mowry Bridge, scheduled to begin construction later this year. Pre-construction activities include special status species surveys and exclusion fencing installation, monitoring and maintenance. Installation of the exclusion fencing will require some vegetation clearing. A separate field activity advisory will be released for Mowry Bridge replacement construction activities as final details become available.

Who: Live Oak Associates, Thunder Mountain Enterprises, Team EES

**What:** Special status species pre-construction surveys, vegetation clearing, and exclusion fencing installation and maintenance.

When: Exclusion fencing installation activities will occur in mid-August. Survey, monitoring and maintenance activities will occur from mid-August through the start of construction activities. Exclusion fencing is anticipated to remain in the project area through the completion of the Mowry Bridge Replacement project.

Where: Activities will take place within the footprint of the Mowry Bridge Replacement Project (Attachment). Access for the activity will occur via Bass Avenue and the BB Limited property.
