Please find attached the revised Allocation and Default flow schedule, effective May 17. This allocation is based on the Most Probable Forecast used by Reclamation's SCCAO Water Supply Program, which corresponds to about 755 TAF unimpaired runoff to Millerton Lake. Allocation for March 1 to May 28 is about 74,956 acre-feet. As of May 16, about 65,056 acre-feet will be released; you have about 9,900 acre-feet to schedule during the last two weeks of Spring flexible period.
