1.0 USGS Assessment of Water Quality Data with Respect to Fish

1.1 Statement of Need

Evaluate water quality data collected by the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation), with respect to established criteria for Chinook salmon. The report will include a summary of the water quality data available and a summary of the available criteria for the protection of fishes. The general schedule for San Joaquin River Restoration Program (SJRRP) data reporting contributions is a draft report to the Fisheries Management Workgroup in February and a final version for public review in March. More specific dates will be assigned in consultation with the Fisheries Management Workgroup as needed.

1.2 Deliverables and Schedule

- 1) Updated or new sections for the SJRRP biannual data reporting, Monitoring and Analysis Plan, or other plans and reports as appropriate.
- 2) USGS Open-File or Scientific Investigation report

The report is in the USGS approval process. Completion of the report is anticipated in Fiscal Year 15.

1.3 Budget

The proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2015 is \$4,620.80.

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
