

## SJRRP Interim Flows Update

## April 12, 2010

## - Interim Flow Increasing on Monday, April 12

On Monday, April 12, at 3 p.m., the Bureau of Reclamation will increase Interim Flow releases from Friant Dam to between 1,500 - 1,600 cubic feet per second (cfs). The flows will be controlled to target less than 1,300 cfs past the Chowchilla Bifurcation Structure and to reduce flows slightly in Reach 4 to 700 cfs to further evaluate potential seepage in that reach. Reclamation will continue to closely monitor and evaluate conditions. This increase originally scheduled for April 6 date was delayed so Reclamation could fully assess the effects of the March 16 and March 29 releases. In May, the Interim Flows will begin to decrease.
