The San Joaquin River Restoration Program (SJRRP) is preparing to remove two weirs on the Merced National Wildlife Refuge as part of the Eastside Bypass Improvement Project in order to help facilitate fish passage within the Eastside Bypass.

Who: Site Work Solutions

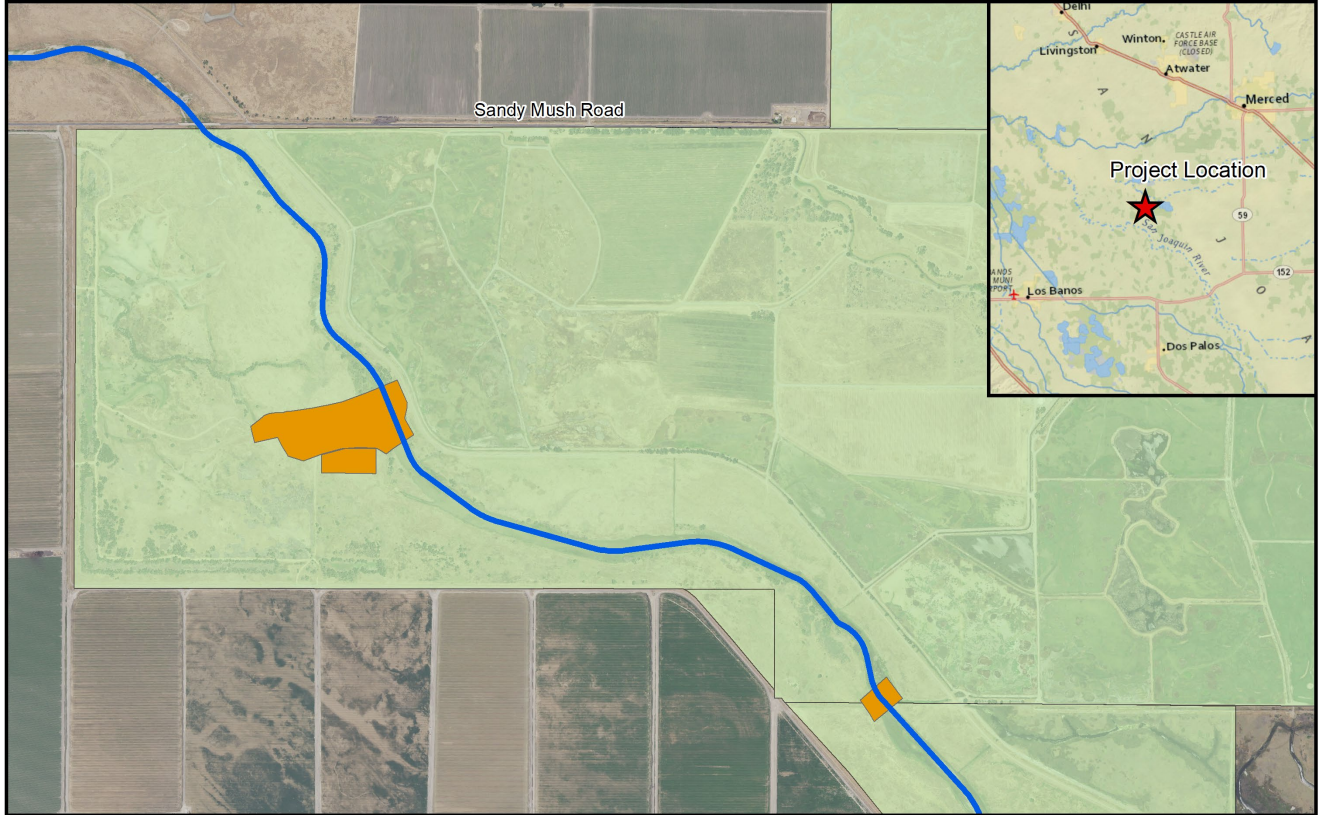
What: Weir removal and low-flow channel regrade

When: August through September 2019

Where: Construction will take place on the Merced National Wildlife Refuge. Access for the construction will occur on public roads and on the Refuge by permit.
