



Field Activity Advisory Reach 2B Biological Monitoring and Geotechnical Explorations April 2020

The San Joaquin River Restoration Program (SJRRP) is preparing to conduct biological monitoring in advance of and during planned geotechnical explorations in critical areas within Reach 2B of the Restoration Area. Figure A, shown below, highlights the activity area. The effort is to inform planning and eventual construction of the Mendota Pool Control Structure and Fish Screen as part of the Reach 2B suite of actions in order to meet the goals of the Restoration Settlement and Settlement Act.

Who: Live Oak Associates, Inc. and Pitcher Service, LLC

What: Live Oak performed biological surveys on Thursday, April 2, 2020 on Reach 2B properties. Starting

the week of April 13, Pitcher Service, LLC will drill four geotechnical samples on levee roads within

the project area. Biological monitoring will continue during the construction period.

When: Thursday, April 2, 2020 and continuing Monday, April 13 through Thursday April 16, 2020

Where: Reach 2B of the San Joaquin River Restoration Area (see Figure A below)
