Flow Schedule

Apurba,

I am writing to confirm my decision to concur with the Default Flow Schedule contained in Table 6 of your May 10 Allocation. Accordingly, I will not be providing an alternative Interim Flow Schedule at this time.

Your suggested Default Flow Schedule in Table 6 is provided below for the benefit of those copied by this response. Based on my concurrence, I expect:

- The current 1100 cfs Interim Flow releases to continue through May 25;
- Interim Flow releases would decrease to 900 cfs on May 26;
- Releases would decrease to 700 cfs on May 27;
- Releases would decrease to 365 cfs on May 28; and
- Finally, releases from Friant Dam would decrease to 350 cfs on May 29.

Starting May 30, Interim Flow releases for the remainder of the Water Year would match the flow schedule set forth in Table 6.
