Rod,

The latest DWR B120 water supply forecast was published on May 29, 2013 as a result of which CVP water supply allocation, Friant Division was increased to 50% on June 5, 2013. The DWR forecast projected about 785 TAF, and 845 TAF unimpaired runoff for 90% and 50% exceedence probability respectively. Friant division water allocation is based on 815 TAF unimpaired runoff to Lake Millerton. As per the draft RFG, the SJRRP has prepared an updated Interim Flow allocation and default flow schedule, effective June 10, 2013. This latest updated Interim Flow allocation will increase the base flow from 268 cfs to 350 cfs during July-August. Please let us know if you have any questions.
